Fair World Builders (FWB) is a local based non-profit organization with a clear vision for communities in Haiti to improve their educational level, increased economic security and promote social inclusion. Our mission is to come up with solutions to tackle the pressing problems of illiteracy, poverty and social discrimination by empowering young people.

Founded in 2019, between students from different universities (State University of Haiti, University of Notre Dame d’Haïti), FWB offers the following: Young Inmates Program, Youth Entrepreneurship Program, Education Upheld Program and climate Justice Program.

Our core values include: Cohesion, Respect, Fairness, and Solidarity.

Youth Entrepreneurship Program

At the core of our actions, young people play a vital role not only because our organization is a youth-led non-profit, but also because they are the pillars of change at every corner of the country. This year, our organization worked with thousands of young people, especially women and girls to make a difference into their life.

Impact:

- 10 000 families benefit from our actions
- 250 women and girls received training about fruits processings
- 150 women and girls received a Revenue Generative Activity to push their small business to the next level





Youth Inmates Program

In a democratic society, the justice system must operate in such a way that citizens are treated equally. Equality and impartiality are the two pre-requisites for a just society. As Reinhold Niebuhr said “Man’s capacity for justice makes democracy possible, but man’s inclination to injustice makes democracy necessary”. This necessity of democracy requires the respect of human rights and an unmatched bound to rule of law.

Unfortunately, many young inmates in Haiti are caught in prisons without the ability to be heard by judge even after three to ten years. This situation undermines the basic principal of the national constitution which requires a maximum 48 hours to trial after being caught. That’s why our team supports young people in Haitian prisons to get their case heard and their sentence known.

Impact:

200 cases appeared into court


9 women and young girls supported

50 young people released

Education Upheld Program

Quality Education is recognized worldwide as a powerful tool to individual elevation. It gives people the ability to think and make important decisions regarding their country, family and themselves. Poor education yields unequivocally poor citizens that are less productive and unable to shift the course of their country into progress.

That is why this year, our organization put forth a new plan to empower teachers and sensitize young people about the importance of education and how to make use of the New Technology so that they can boost their know-how and knowledge to the next level.



Impact:

15 000 young people received trainings

200 professors trained

8 000 young women and girls impacted

Climate Justice Program

As humans, the air we breathe, the food we eat and the water we drink which are most essential for our survival depend on the health of our blue planet earth. Climate change becomes the greatest Armageddon threaten our future upon it as species. The main problem is not the climate change itself because this happened long time ago, it is the pace human activities accelerated that change which causes the nightmare.

In this Anthropocene era, our organization reminds itself constantly about the place of Haiti in this uncertain time. Several reports put forth the impact of climate change upon farmers, rural communities and the country as a whole because natural catastrophes become recurrent and the country lose, each year, millions of dollars and thousands of lives be it from earthquakes, floods, cyclone...


