







Letter from Co-Founder and COO


Dear Friends and supporters,

Youth Empowerment to tackle Fake news

With the support of Global Youth Mobilization, Fair World Builders empowered young people in northeast to light up their communities in the time of COVID-19. Through this program, 75 young people from 15 communities were empowered.

In Northeast of Haiti, Fair World Builders team worked with young people in the grassroots to make sure they know how to differentiate facts from fake news because there were many hoaxes and infox

around the internet about the issue.



Through these sessions, we also realized workshops and simulation so that young leaders can go to their respective community to show the way to flatten the curve of SARS-COV-2.


